MAYOR TORY, STOP HIDING BEHIND THE FACTS ON THE SCARBOROUGH SUBWAY  
EXTENSION.

Members of Scarborough Transit Action, a volunteer group that speaks up for transit riders in Scarborough, are frustrated that the Scarborough Subway Extension report was delayed, *again*.

“Could it be that this project is not viable? That the costs have gone up again, and Mayor Tory is afraid to tell us? If that is the case, we need to deal with this report now, before we dig ourselves any deeper,” said Scarborough Transit Action Chair, Brenda Thompson

“We have serious concerns that the vote in July was based on inaccurate information about the feasibility the LRT option. This second delay shows predictions about the subway option may not be as optimistic as originally thought,” said Scarborough Transit Action member Khalidha Nasiri.

“This is very frustrating, because the seven-stop Scarborough LRT was shovel-ready, at 100% design. Construction could start at the north end, now”, said Moya Beall, Scarborough Transit Action member.

Scarborough Transit Action, in cooperation with several independent citizens, has submitted a formal complaint to TTC CEO Andy Byford with regard to the lack of a credible, objective comparison of the LRT option.
